


Join with the MHNO in February!

The next Planning Board Workshop on the recommended Munjoy Hill Historic District is scheduled for Tuesday, February 11, 2020 at 4:30 in Council Chambers. This is the second workshop. A public hearing is likely to be scheduled in early March.
