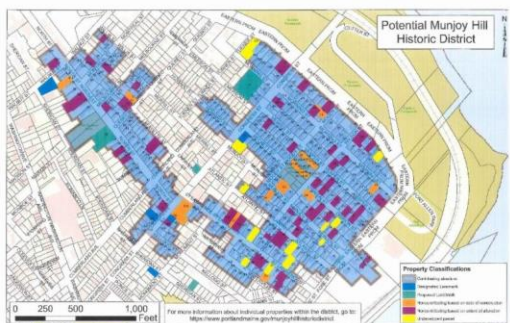

Why has the Historic Preservation Board recommended that about half of Munjoy Hill be designated as a Historic District?

Why does the Munjoy Hill Neighborhood Organization support that designation?
