PORTLAND'S CHARTER COMMISSION ELECTION IS JUNE 8TH. TWO GOOD OPPORTUNITIES TO ASSESS THE CANDIDATES:

Portland's newly-forming 12-member charter commission could recommend substantial changes for Portland's city government charter. Topics may include public campaign funding for local elections, the balance of power between the city manager and the mayor, the role of the mayor, qualifications of voters, district vs. at-large councilors, and many other issues. Its recommendations for changes will eventually go to Portland's voters.

The Munjoy Hill Neighborhood Organization is hosting a remote candidates' forum on **Monday, May 10th, from 7 - 8:30 pm** for the **DISTRICT 1 CANDIDATES:** Twain Braden, David Cowie, Karen Snyder and Shamika (Shay) Stewart-Bouley. One of these candidate


