Earth Day Clean Up Friday, April 22nd

The MHNO will be sponsoring its annual Clean Up of Munjoy Hill on Earth Day, **Friday, April 22nd**. The effort will focus on portions of the Eastern Prom Park.

There will be two shifts of volunteers:

- Wave #1: 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm, and
- Wave #2, 3:00 to 5:00.

Please meet at the Midslope parking lot on Cutter Street, below the sledding hill. All ages welcome.

This year there will be two project areas in Eastern Promenade Park. One will involve invasive removal in the midslope area. This Invasive Project is headed by Portland Parks and Maine Audubon. The goal is to remove the bittersweet and multiflora in order to plant habitat more supportive of birds and pollinators.

The second project, requiring less strenuous labor, will involve trash pickup along the coastline and trails around the East End Beach.

- Trash bags
- Trash pickers
- Gloves
- Shovels
- Rakes
- Loppers

Volunteers Should Bring:

- Long sleeved shirt
- Long pants
- Sturdy shoes
- Water to drink
- Work gloves (if prefer own)

City's Charter Commission Continues its Work: Next Meeting Wednesday, April 13th at 6 pm

The Charter Commission is continuing its work to examine the City's Charter to decide what changes, if any, to recommend. They are continuing to work toward the goal of having their recommendation(s) appear on the November 2022 ballot.

The there are a multiplicity of topics being addressed. The Commission is meeting weekly to try to get through all of the proposals.

The next Charter Commission meeting is Wednesday, April 13th at 6:00 pm. Among the items on the agenda (as it is currently posted) are:

- Public hearing, deliberation and vote on School Budget Autonomy proposal and Capital Improvement Program Process proposal, both from the Education Committee, and Code of Ethics proposal from the Procedures Committee;
- First Read of the Governance Proposal, as converted into charter language by Attorney Katsiaficas with the intent of capturing the series of "straw votes" on reforms to the basic structure of Portland's government taken over the last few meetings (no public comment scheduled);
- First Read of a new proposal for an Office of Information, sponsored by Commissioner O'Brien;

- Ratification of final language for the Preamble and Land Acknowledgment and vote on whether to send the proposal to the voters;
- Public hearing, deliberation and vote on School Board Vacancies proposal.
