

#### Snow & Ice Clearing for Sidewalks:


For Residents, must be cleared within 24-hours after the City completes clearing snow.

For Business, must be cleared within 12-hours after the City completes clearing snow.

Residents & Businesses are required to clear sidewalks to the abutting property.



### Take It Easy While Shoveling!




Begin slowly and take frequent, 15-minute breaks

Drink plenty of water to avoid dehydration Dress in layers, to avoid hypothermia (low body temperature) or overheating

Cover your head and neck (50% body heat lost thru head and neck)

Cover your mouth (breathing cold air can cause angina or trigger breathing problems)

Watch for warning signs of a heart attack, lightheadedness, dizziness, being short of breath, or if you have tightness or burning in chest, neck, arms or back. If you think you are having a heart attack, call 911
