## Dedication of Eastern Promenade Memorial to Jacob Thompson

There are a couple of things happening on Portland's Munjoy Hill this week that we thought you'd want to know about.

Perhaps the most important is a presentation by the City of Portland's Historic Preservation Program on Thursday, November 15.

'Owning Property in a Historic District - What Does it Mean?' will be presented by Historic Preservation Program Manager Deb Andrews and is meant as an informative session for property owners on Munjoy Hill.

What types of alterations or construction activities typically require review and approval in Portland's historic districts? By what standards are projects reviewed? Who conducts those reviews and how long does it take to reach approval? Are there resources available to assist property owners with their projects and what are the benefits of historic district designation?

These and other questions will be answered in an informational session as the City explores the possibility of historic district designation for a portion of Munjoy Hill. This is an excellent opportunity to learn about the potential effect of designation in the Munjoy Hill neighborhood.
